



EnergICE Mangochi and Nkhotakota

EnDev in Mangochi and Nkhotakota, programme under GIZ 2022-2024

Implementing partner: Energizing Development and sub-contractors

Programme period: 1st February 2023 – 31st of December 2024

Budget: €1.000.000

Location: Mangochi District and Nkhotakota District

Summary: Iceland's partnership with GIZ-Energising Development programme (EnDev) focuses on providing schools and health facilities with access to clean and renewable solar energy, increasing the use of clean and more fuel efficient cookstoves in schools and guardian shelters, and promoting fuel efficient fish processing with the Chitofu 3-in-1.

This is the Embassy's second project with EnDev, the first project in Mangochi ended in 2022.



6 guardian cooking shelters at health centres in Nkhotakota will be equipped with ten Chitetezo Mbaula Stoves, **which save 60% more energy than regular cooking stoves.** The shelters were also fitted with solar power lighting for easier use in the dark and greater security. 8 shelters in Mangochi will be upgraded.



19 by the end of the project 19 social institutions (15 schools and 4 health centres) in Nkhotakota **will have solar electricity systems.**



the usage of Chitofu 3-in-1 energy saving fish processing stoves will be promoted in Mangochi and Nkhotakota. EnDev will focus on improving the usage of existing Chitofu's in Mangochi, pilot a mobile version of the stove and introduce it in Nkhotakota.



12 schools in Mangochi (4) and Nkhotakota (8) will receive **portable fuel efficient stoves that will facilitate the delivery of school meals.**
