# 3. Purpose of research and general operational methods

The Greenland halibut stock at East Greenland and Iceland is considered a common stock. The management advice for the stock is formulated by ICES Northwestern Working Group (NWWG). Greenland and Iceland have conducted bottom trawl surveys in there national waters for a number of years, but NWWG finds it difficult to evaluate the trends and compare the results of the two surveys because they are conducted with different vessels and gear. By means of parallel trawling with bottom otter trawl between the Greenland Research vessel Paamiut and the Iceland Research vessel Arni Fredriksson it will possible to compare the catchability of Greenland halibut by the two vessels and hence adjust the survey results from Greenland and Icelandic waters in order to make the results comparable.

The experiment is conducted in close cooperation with Marine Research Institute (MIR) in connection to MIR's annual autumn grounfish survey and trawling will take place at MIR's fixed stations.

There has been allocated three days to the experiment and it is expected to cover 20-30 fixed stations. Each trawl haul will last 30 min. The total catch is likely to be less than 10 tons.

Prior to the experiment Paamiut is operating in Greenland waters close to the area where the Icelandic survey is taking place. It is, however, not likely that we will have this opportunity to make comparative hauls between the two vessels, at a relatively low cost, within a foreseeable future.


